

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 7, 2008

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Kaczanowski at 7:03 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Davis moved and seconded by VanHaitsma to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held January 17, 2008. Motion carried.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by VanDorp to approve the minutes of the special meeting held January 24, 2008. Motion carried.

No public comments.

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Saunders to approve bills in the amount of \$32,973.75. Motion carried.

New business included:

1) Results from sewer petitions

Supervisor Kaczanowski reviewed the final results of the petitions against proposed sewer district #5, as follows: 298 parcels of the 565 parcels in the proposed district petitioned against (280 homeowners and 18 businesses); a total of 292.96 acres or 50 percent of the total acreage petitioned against the proposed sewer district.

2) Bid from Advance Newspaper

VanDorp moved and seconded by Dolegowski to accept the bid from the Advance Newspapers for legal advertising at \$3.56 per column inch for copy sent electronically and \$3.75 per column inch for copy sent by fax/hardcopy. Motion carried.

3) Summer tax collection

Treasurer Saunders informed the Board that Wayland Union Schools have agreed to pay \$3.00/parcel for the tax collections (down from \$3.40/parcel currently).

4) Primary resurfacing report

Supervisor Kaczanowski reviewed the Allegan County Road Commission's 5-year resurfacing plan.
