

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD JUNE 5, 2008

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Kaczanowski at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Don Kaczanowski, Jodi Brummel, Jan Saunders, Larry Dolegowski, and Don VanDorp.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Tammy VanHaitsma and Paul Davis
(22 visitors)

Presentation of a Certificate of Appreciation plaque was made to the Dorr Township Board by Lyle Shanks of the American Legion Post 127 in appreciation for the purchase of the new veterans graveside flag holders and flags.

Presentation was made by Jeff Farnsworth, Republican candidate for State Representative.

Saunders moved and seconded by VanDorp to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held May 15, 2008. Motion carried.

Public comments included concern about curb painting, drainage issues, and resealing of the Complex parking lot.

No changes or additions to the agenda.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by VanDorp to approve bills in the amount of \$52,163.99. Motion carried.

No communications.

The following reports were given: 1) Fire Department by Harold Schumaker and 2) Planning Commission by Larry Dolegowski.

During the Fire Department report, Chief Schumaker indicated that the Fire Department would like to promote Gary Fordham to the 2nd Lieutenant position.

VanDorp moved and seconded by Saunders to approve the promotion of Gary Fordham to the 2nd Lieutenant position within the Dorr Township Fire Department. Motion carried.

No old business.

New business included:

1) Opening of bids on Township pick-up truck

Twelve bids were received and opened for the 1998 Dodge Ram pick-up with snow plow, as follows: Jim Kooinga \$100; Bernard Schumaker \$105; Michael Smith \$137; John A. VanDorp \$200; Thomas Powell II \$261.99; Rick Damveld \$325.08; Tim Bekkering \$400; Jeff Miling \$451.51; Scott Limber \$526; Dan Reed \$626.08; Barbara Belka \$700; and Hank Chachulski \$900.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by VanDorp to accept the high bid of \$900, submitted by Hank Chachulski, for the 1988 Dodge Ram ½ ton pick-up truck with snow plow. Motion carried.

2) Reply from MDOT on installing 3-way stop at expressway

Supervisor Kaczanowski informed the Board that a response was received from MDOT indicating that a site review was conducted and they will not be installing a stop sign at the US-131 northbound exit ramp to 142nd Avenue at this time.

3) 2008 Equalization report for Dorr Township

Supervisor Kaczanowski gave a brief overview of Dorr Township's information.

4) Request from Dorr Moose Lodge #2541 for new Entertainment permit

In order for the Lodge to conduct raffles, the Liquor Control Commission informed them they need to have an Entertainment permit.

Saunders moved and seconded by Brummel to approve a resolution for Dorr Lodge No. 2541, Loyal Order of Moose, request of new Entertainment permit, to be held in conjunction with 2007 Club licensed business, with Sunday Sales permit, Dance permit, and Outdoor Service. Motion carried.

5) Roger Plaiser property clean-up

Discussion was held regarding the condition of Mr. Plaiser's property. Supervisor Kaczanowski indicated that due to complaints received, several meetings have been held with Mr. Plaiser, PCI, and himself and a clean-up plan has now been established with bi-weekly check-ups on progress. The Civil Infraction Ordinance will be enforced should acceptable progress not be made. Supervisor Kaczanowski to update the Board on the clean-up progress each month.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Saunders to adjourn. Motion carried.
