

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD MARCH 20, 2008

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Kaczanowski at 7:03 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Don Kaczanowski, Jodi Brummel, Jan Saunders, Larry Dolegowski, Tammy VanHaitsma, and Paul Davis.

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Davis to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held March 6, 2008. Motion carried.

Public comments included an inquiry about recycling availability for businesses.

No changes or additions to the agenda.

No payment of bills due to the end of the fiscal year and budget finalization.

Communications included a thank-you letter received from the Dorr PTO for providing a place for their meetings.

The following reports were given: 1) Treasurer's report by Saunders; 2) Ambulance report by Supervisor Kaczanowski; and 3) Parks report by Steve Wolbrink.

No old business.

New business included:

1) Amendment of 2007-08 budget

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Saunders to amend the budget, as follows: Increase Insurance from \$11,000 to \$13,100 and decrease Complex from \$40,400 to \$38,300. Motion carried.

2) 57<sup>th</sup> District Court Community Service Program

Supervisor Kaczanowski informed the Board that a letter was received from the 57<sup>th</sup> District Court informing the Township of the implementation of a community service program being managed through their Court. A form must be completed and returned to them indicating interest.

3) Request to proclaim April, 2008, as Child Abuse Prevention Month

Supervisor Kaczanowski informed the Board that a letter was received from Safe Harbor, a Children's Advocacy Center located in Allegan, requesting that April, 2008, be proclaimed as Child Abuse Prevention Month. Supervisor Kaczanowski proceeded to proclaim the month of April, 2008, as Child Abuse Prevention Month in Dorr Township.

4) 2008 Board of Review report

Supervisor Kaczanowski gave a brief explanation of the 2008 Board of Review results.

5) Report on Rural Task Force Meeting

Supervisor Kaczanowski attended the Allegan County Rural Task Force Meeting held on Friday, March 14. He informed the Board that the 142<sup>nd</sup> Avenue reconstruction funding has been secured. The Board will have to make a decision whether to complete the project in segments in 2009 and 2010 or to hold off and complete the project entirely in 2010.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Saunders to adjourn. Motion carried.
