

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 18, 2008

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Kaczanowski at 7:03 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A plaque was presented to Doug Montgomery for his ten years of service on the Dorr Township Planning Commission.

A presentation was made by William Baillargeon, incumbent candidate for Circuit Court Judge.

VanDorp moved and seconded by VanHaitsma to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held September 4, 2008. Motion carried.

A presentation was made by Kevin Cronin, candidate for Circuit Court Judge.

Davis moved and seconded by Saunders to approve bills in the amount of \$89,623.34. Motion carried.

Old business included:

- 1) Drainage problem on Junglas property

Because many residents have indicated drainage problems, a meeting has been set for Friday, September 19, 2008, to view and discuss the drainage problems and decide on a recommendation for solution.

- 2) Old police car

New business included:

- 1) Proposed new sewer district and costs

- 2) Road counts on intersection of 18<sup>th</sup> Street and 142<sup>nd</sup> Avenue

- 3) Six-month recycling report
