

SPECIAL DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 18, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 6:35 p.m.

Reason for the meeting was to discuss the mutually-owned police vehicles due to Salem Township's decision to discontinue their participation in the joint community policeing with Dorr and Leighton Township, beginning June 1, 2009.

No public comments.

Discussion was held regarding various issues of the mutually-owned contract police vehicles.

Jim Pitsch moved and seconded by Don Sebright that Salem Township continues to pay their shared portion of the remaining balance of the Dodge Charger police vehicle, consisting of two remaining annual payments, as the original payment schedule requires. ROLL CALL VOTE: Jim Pitsch YES; Randy Boyles YES; Don Sebright YES; and Betty Brower YES (4 YES, 0 NO). Motion carried.

Jim Pitsch moved and seconded by Don Sebright that upon dispersement of either police vehicle, one-third of the dispersement price would be equally distributed to Dorr, Leighton, and Salem Townships. ROLL CALL VOTE: Char Troost YES; Jan Saunders YES; Larry Dolegowski YES; Dan Weber YES; Josh Otto YES; Betty Brower YES; Randy Boyles YES; Don Sebright YES; Jim Pitsch YES; Kevin DeKam YES; Jodi Brummel YES; Tammy VanHaitsma YES; and John Hooker YES (13 YES; 0 NO). Motion carried.

Public comments were heard. Discussion was held on the insurance coverage of the police vehicles. Clarification was made that the current insurance policy for the two police vehicles is paid until November, 2009. After that point, continued insurance coverage will be the responsibility of Dorr and Leighton Townships.

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to adjourn. Motion carried.
