

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD APRIL 16, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Tammy VanHaitsma, Jodi Brummel, Jan Saunders, Larry Dolegowski, Paul Davis, Josh Otto, and Dan Weber

No changes or additions to the agenda.

Public comments were heard.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Otto to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) Library report by Patty Moore and 2) Treasurer report by Jan Saunders.

Saunders moved and seconded by Davis to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held April 2, 2009. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Weber to approve bills in the amount of \$32,287.13. Motion carried.

Old business included:

1) Complex policy

Discussion was held. Otto to revise and present to the Board.

2) Gravel recommendations

Discussion was held on gravel considerations at the following locations: 16th Street between 140th and 142nd Avenue; 137th Avenue between 20th and 22nd Street; 140th Avenue between 18th and 21st Street (partial); 144th Avenue between 21st and 22nd Street; 145th Avenue between 22nd and 24th Street (spot repair); 16th Street between 144th and 108th Street; 21st Street between 138th and 140th Avenue; 21st Street between 142nd Avenue and 108th Street (spot repair).

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Otto to gravel roads, as presented but to exclude 137th Avenue between 20th and 22nd Street, 16th Street between 144th and 108th Street, and the west end of 145th Avenue. Motion carried.

3) Sewer update

Supervisor VanHaitsma indicated that sufficient petitions against the project have been received so the project is not moving forward at this time.

New business included:

1) Accept Joyce Denstone's resignation from Planning Commission

Brummel moved and seconded by Saunders to accept the resignation of Joyce Denstone from the Planning Commission, effective June 1, 2009. Motion carried.
