

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD AUGUST 20, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

No changes or additions to the agenda.

Public comments were heard.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Otto to approve the agenda with the correction of "Approval of the August 6, 2009 regular meeting minutes." Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) County Commissioner by Paul VanEck; 2) Treasurer by Jan Saunders; and 3) Library by Patty Moore.

Otto moved and seconded by Davis to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held August 6, 2009. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Weber to approve bills in the amount of \$62,058.62. Motion carried.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Davis to approve bills previously paid in the amount of \$304.62. Motion carried.

No old business.

New business included:

1) PA 116 – Steven and Danielle Berens

Weber moved and seconded by Brummel to approve the PA116 request for the parcel located in Section 34, T4N, R12W, Dorr Township, Allegan County, Michigan for Steven and Danielle Berens. Motion carried.

2) Recycling – electronic and yard waste

Discussion was held on using the Township property on 140<sup>th</sup> Avenue for yard waste composting. Further investigation and discussion to be held.

Weber moved and seconded by Otto to approve Dorr Township's participation in the electronic recycling program. Motion carried.

3) Meth rehabilitation donations

Donations of \$2,500 are being requested by each Township. Supervisor VanHaitsma to further investigate.

4) Maintenance agreement for heating/cooling system

A maintenance agreement with Pleune Service Company for four quarterly check-ups for \$160/quarter or \$640 annually was discussed. After discussion, the Board decided to have maintenance performed on an on-call basis.

5) Investment policy

The policy is being reviewed and will be presented at a later meeting for adoption.
