

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD JANUARY 7, 2010

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Changes or additions to the agenda included the addition of "Easements for Road Commission" under the New Business section.

Public comments were heard.

Otto moved and seconded by Davis to approve the agenda with the addition of Easements for Road Commission under New Business. Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) Planning Commission by Larry Dolegowski

Otto moved and seconded by Davis to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held December 17, 2009. Motion carried.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Weber to approve bills in the amount of \$43,132.66. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve bills previously paid in the amount of \$7,262.17. Motion carried.

A letter was read from an Allegan County Deputy to thank the Dorr and Leighton Township Boards for the decision to retain the two community deputies which resulted in the retention of her job.

New business included:

1) Hardship Exemption: Poverty Guidelines Resolution 2010

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Saunders to adopt Resolution 01-10R Dorr Township 2010 Poverty Guidelines Resolution. Roll Call Vote: Weber YES; Saunders YES; Brummel YES; VanHaitsma YES; Dolegowski YES; Otto YES; and Davis YES (7 YES, 0 NO). Motion carried.

2) Board meeting dates for 2010

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Otto to hold one Board meeting each month beginning in February for the remainder of the 2010 calendar year. Roll Call Vote: Davis NO; Otto YES; Dolegowski YES; VanHaitsma YES; Brummel YES; Saunders YES; and Weber YES (6 YES, 1 NO). Motion carried.

3) Easements for Road Commission

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve the permanent easements between the Allegan County Road Commission and Dorr Township. Motion carried.
