

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD MAY 21, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

Otto moved and seconded by Brummel to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) Treasurer by Jan Saunders; 2) Planning Commission by Larry Dolegowski; and 3) Ambulance by Josh Otto.

Weber moved and seconded by Saunders to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held May 7, 2009. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve bills in the amount of \$21,201.90. Motion carried.

Old business included:

1) Complex policy

New business included:

1) Reappointment to Zoning Board of Appeals

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Brummel to reappoint John Bouterse to a 3-year term on the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion carried.

2) Resolution to adopt transfer of responsibility of Capital Improvement Plan from Planning Commission to Township Board

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Otto to keep the CIP responsibility with the Planning Commission. Motion carried.

3) Sewer update

Supervisor VanHaitsma informed the Board that Roger Swets made a presentation to the DDA to move ahead with sewer on a voluntary participation with the DDA bonding the cost for those not participating. A public hearing will be held on June 18, 2009, to revise the DDA plan to include the sewer cost amount.

4) Effectiveness survey reminder

Supervisor VanHaitsma requested that all Board members turn in their surveys by next meeting and to think about a mission statement.
