

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 19, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Tammy VanHaitsma, Jodi Brummel, Jan Saunders, Larry Dolegowski, Paul Davis, Josh Otto, and Dan Weber

MEMBERS ABSENT: None

ALSO PRESENT: Roger Swets, Clark Hill PLC (arrived 7:05 p.m.)
(45 visitors)

The public hearing for the Dorr Leighton Special Assessment Sewer District #5 was delayed due to the late arrival of the Township attorney because of a traffic hold-up. The Board proceeded with the agenda items.

Changes or additions to the agenda included the addition of "Correspondence from Pat Foster" and "Amendment of form 591 of special assessments" under the New Business section.

The following reports were given: 1) Library report was read by Supervisor VanHaitsma and 2) Planning Commission report by Larry Dolegowski.

Upon arrival of Roger Swets, the public hearing for the Dorr Leighton Special Assessment Sewer District #5 was opened at 7:06 p.m.

Roger Swets explained the purpose of the public hearing.

Public comments were heard.

VanHaitsma moved and seconded by Otto to approve a resolution to confirm the special assessment roll; lien; and payment and collection of special assessment with the first assessment payment date of April 1, 2010. Roll Call Vote: Dolegowski YES; Saunders YES; VanHaitsma YES; Otto YES; Brummel YES; Davis YES; and Weber YES (7 YES, 0 NO). Motion carried.

The public hearing was closed at 7:20 p.m., at which time the Board resumed with the remaining agenda items.

Public comments were heard.

Brummel moved and seconded by Otto to approve the agenda with the changes of additions of "Correspondence from Pat Foster" and "Amendment of form 591 of special assessments." Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) Treasurer's report by Saunders and 2) Community policing report by Deputy Damveld.

Supervisor VanHaitsma acknowledged the receipt of a letter dated 11/11/09 from Pat Foster.

Otto moved and seconded by Saunders to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held November 5, 2009. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve bills in the amount of \$34,243.91. Motion carried.

Saunders moved and seconded by Weber to approve bills previously paid in the amount of \$336.59. Motion carried.

Old business included:

1) Sewer upcharge

Discussion was held on the sewer upcharge for those properties who would join Sewer District #5 at a later time. The Dorr Leighton Sewer Authority Board will present their decision to the Township Board for adoption at a later date.

2) Community policing

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to adopt the recommendations and funding formula suggested by the Police Recommendation Committee. Motion carried.

New business included:

1) Amendment of form 591 of special assessments

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Otto to amend the streetlighting special assessment from \$24,000 to \$51,000 due to a clerical error. Motion carried.

Public comments were heard.

Dolegowski moved and seconded by Otto to adjourn. Motion carried.
