

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD OCTOBER 1, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:01 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Changes or additions included the addition of Community Policing Update under New Business.

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve the agenda with the addition of Community Policing Update under the New Business section. Motion carried.
