

DORR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 3, 2009

Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanHaitsma at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Correspondence included a thank-you letter to Dorr Township Fire Department from Dorr CRC VBS and a thank-you letter to Dorr Township Fire Department from Harold and Marilyn Johnson for their reponse to their house fire.

Announcements included notification to the Board that the Planning Commission minutes and a letter from Western Insurance has been handed out to each Board member.

No changes or additions to the agenda.

Public comments were heard.

Davis moved and seconded by Otto to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

The following reports were given: 1) County Commissioner by Mark DeYoung; 2) Fire Department by Chief Schumaker; 3) Planning Commission by Larry Dolegowski; 4) Parks Commission by Ken Rearick; and 5) Community Policing by Deputy Beute.

Otto moved and seconded by Saunders to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held August 20, 2009. Motion carried.

Weber moved and seconded by Dolegowski to approve bills in the amount of \$32,748.60. Motion carried.

Otto moved and seconded by Weber to approve bills previously paid in the amount of \$3,714.39. Motion carried.

No old business.

New business included:

- 1) Adopt amending ordinance to mixed planned unit development ordinance

Brummel moved and seconded by Saunders to adopt an ordinance to amend the ordinance originally adopted August 6, 2009, to correct the numbering of sections in that ordinance adopted August 6, 2009. Motion carried.

- 2) Adopt composting ordinance

Otto moved and seconded by Dolegowski to adopt an ordinance to amend the zoning ordinance of Dorr Township by adding section 4.43 composting facilities to chapter 4 general provisions. Roll Call Vote: Weber YES; Saunders YES; Brummel YES; VanHaitsma YES; Dolegowski YES; Otto YES; and Davis YES (7 YES, 0 NO). Motion carried.

- 3) Update on 142<sup>nd</sup> Avenue reconstruction and MDOT US131/142<sup>nd</sup> Avenue bridge project

An update on the two projects was given by Supervisor VanHaitsma.

- 4) Handicap doors for Township complex

Discussion was held. The Board decided to investigate the cost and further discuss.

- 5) MTA upcoming events
