A: An Amendment to Regulate Medical Marijuana:

The proposed amendment sets forth regulations on how medical marijuana can be sold and distributed in the township. This prohibits the operation of a shop or store front but allows caregivers to grow and distribute from their home as long as all State guidelines are followed, i.e. plants are kept in a secure building under lock and key, the caregiver has up to 5 patients, and can only grow 12 plants per patient. The board will be reviewing this amendment and sending it on to the township lawyer for review.

B: An Amendment to Regulate Electronic Message Boards: The proposed amendment would regulate the brightness and speed of the sign. It also regulates the type in which the message can be written in regards to flashing, blinking animation and the like. This amendment was reviewed line by line changes were made in regards to grandfathering in pre-existing electronic message boards and other matters. This amendment will now be changed to reflect these notes and reviewed again at a later meeting.
