PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Planning Commission of Dorr Township will conduct a public hearing concerning the following matters to be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at Dorr Township Hall, located at 4196 18th Street, Dorr, MI.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the item(s) to be considered include, in brief, the following:

1. An amendment to the Dorr Township Zoning Ordinance, Sections 8.05 (b) and 8.05 (c) to regulate lot width and lot area for lots serving single and two-family dwellings in the B-2 Residential Zoning District.
2. Such other and further business as may properly come before the Planning Commission.

A copy of the application and related materials is available for review at Dorr Township Hall during regular business hours. Written comments will be received from any interested persons concerning the foregoing application(s) by the Dorr Township Clerk at the Township Hall at any time during regular business hours up to the date of the hearing and may be further received by the Planning Commission at the hearing. All interested persons are invited and urged to participate.
