

November Election

The upcoming 2020 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The ballot will include the offices U.S. President/Vice President, U.S. Senator (1 seat), U.S. Representative in Congress (all 14 districts in Michigan), State Representative (all 100 districts), State Board of Education (2 seats), University of Michigan Regents (2 seats), Michigan State Trustees (2 seats), Wayne State University Governors (2 seats), and more, including local races.

Polls will be open from 7 AM to 8 PM on Election Day. This election is expected to have a high voter turnout. Please expect long lines (that may even extend out of the building), so please plan for a period of time to work through the precinct room and vote. The precinct and the workers will be set up with social distancing and health/safety procedures and all voters are being asked to follow those same guidelines.

You might consider voting via absentee ballot and skip the line! All registered voters in the State can request an absentee ballot. Simply call the Township office (681-9874, ext. 102) to request an application – one can be mailed to you or you may fill one out at the Township office.

If you need to register to vote, you can fill out a form online at www.michigan.gov/vote that can be printed, signed and mailed (or dropped off) to the local Clerk. If you register after October 19, 2020, you will need to visit your local Clerk to register in person with proof of residency in order to vote in the November election.

Upcoming Election Deadlines

End of September/beginning of October	First round of Absentee Ballots are mailed from the Township Clerk's Office
October 20 through 8 PM on November 3, 2020	In-person registration with the Township Clerk with proof of residency
October 30 before 5 PM (office is only open Monday – Thursday)	Deadline for voters to request an Absentee Ballot to be sent via postal mail.
October 31 8AM – 4PM	Office open for Absentee Ballots
November 2 before 4 PM	Deadline for voters to request an Emergency Ballot in person at the Township Clerk's Office (must vote ballot in the Township Office).
November 3 – Election Day!	Polls open 7AM to 8PM Emergency Ballots must be returned to Dorr Township Office no later than 8PM.
