 - c. Section 13A.04 Area Regulations (in the Rural Agricultural district)
 - d. Section 14.05 Area Regulations (in the Agricultural district)

2. Such other and further business as may properly come before the Planning Commission.

Written comments will be received from any interested persons concerning the foregoing application(s) by the Dorr Township Clerk at the Township Hall at any time during regular business hours up to the date of the hearing and may be further received by the Planning Commission at the hearing. All interested persons are invited and urged to participate.
